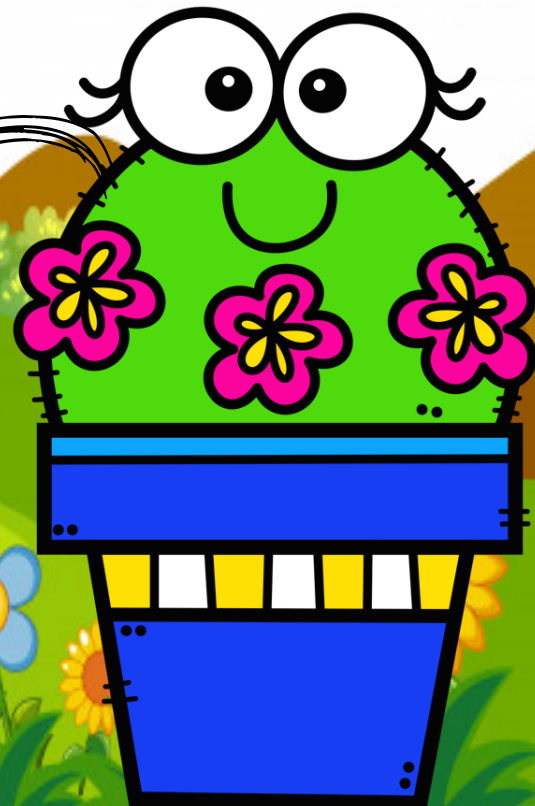
What is the goal of this experiment?

# How to make a grass head

Making grass heads is a fun little gardening project the kids will love watching grow. Here's what you are going to need:

## Materials

- Stocking
- Cotton wool
- Scissors
- Googly eyes
- Marker pen
- Pipe cleaners
- Plastic cup
- Sphagnum moss
- Elastic band
- Spray bottle
- Craft glue
- Packet of grass seeds

## Safety

It's a good idea to supervise your kids during this project, especially when they're using scissors or glue.



### Step 1

Start by cutting out the feet of an old pair of stockings, just above the ankle.



### Step 2

Then fill up your stocking starting with some grass seeds and sphagnum moss. Now tie it into about a tennis ball size shape to make your head.



### Step 3

Pinch the front of the head to make your nose then hold it in place with an elastic band.



### Step 4

Now put your face on. You can stick on some googly eyes, draw on a mouth and use your pipe cleaner to make some eyebrows or even a little moustache.



### Step 5

Next, glue some paper onto your plastic cup and have some fun drawing on an outfit. You can even cut out a little tie shape to glue on.



### Step 6

Half fill your plastic cup with water and place your head on top, so the stocking tail is dangling in the water. Now place him up on a window sill to get lots of sun. Give him a little squirt of water with your spray bottle every day, and watch him grow!
